- James 1:21 – Learning Scripture
- 1 Peter 3:15 – In Witnessing

## The Comrades of Meekness:

- Ephesians 4:1-2 – Lowliness and Longsuffering
- Colossians 3:12 – Humbleness of Mind and Bowels of Mercies
- Tit. 3:2 – Gentleness
- 1 Peter 3:4 – A Quiet Spirit

## The Consequences of Meekness:

- Psalm 25:9 – God's Guidance (Why? Because They will respond)
- Psalm 37:11 / Psalm 147:6 / Mathhew 5:5 – God's Exaltation and Confidence to Entrust (Why? Because they will be grave and responsible and compassionate with their position)
